| 9. | Yard Trimming Collection Option Consideration
Discussions will be held on a possible option for the schedule of yard trimming (claw) collections. The option would add 3 collections per year during leaf fall season (November, December & January). The cost of these extra collections would be proportional to the number of annual collections (i.e., 25% additional cost due to the 15 collections compared to the current 12 collections per year). The option would result in an additional \$8.92/month (\$107.04 annually). Currently, Willowbank residents pay \$428.40 annually for claw collections. Overall, Recology fees are typically \$902.28 annually. The Committee will eventually decide if this option should be put to a vote of the property owners or, alternately, if the option should not be allowed to be considered by the property owners. If, in the future, the Committee recommends that the Supervisor formally obtain the homeowners’ preference of the leaf-fall option | Lawyer |

compared to the current once-a-month collection schedule, this preference would be decided democratically by a ballot sent by post to all Old Willowbank property owners by Yolo County.
