Project Title: Knights Landing Flood Management Project – Drainage Infrastructure Improvements

Project Applicant and Lead Agency: County of Yolo, 625 Court Street, Room 202, Woodland, CA 95695

Project Location: Within the Town of Knights Landing in Yolo County, CA along 2nd Street and Railroad Street

Project Description: The project would incorporate roadside ditch improvements along 2nd Street between the Post Office and Railroad Street to improve storm water drainage capacity; build a closed conduit under Railroad Street between 2nd Street and 4th Street (approximately 2.25-foot-wide by 1-foot-deep); an open channel along the east side of Railroad Street between 4th Street and 7th Street (approximately 3-foot-deep, 2:1 side slopes); removal of the existing concrete arch culvert; and degrade of the abandoned railroad embankment using a 50-foot-wide open cut channel.

This to advise that the County of Yolo, acting as the Lead Agency, approved the above-described project on May 10, 2022, and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A **Negative Declaration** was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA and adopted by the County.
