 - a) Topics for Community Forum

 - (2) G. Moris passed business cards to S. Reed for Yolo Sheriffs OHV specialist and resident deputy for Capay Valley.
 - ii) Topics for forum

- (1) Caltrans sidewalks – bulbouts more noticeable on side streets, not as much on 16.
- (2) CSD – street lighting. PG&E states that rate structure changed, makes CSD fully responsible to change street lights – CSD needs to sub that out.
 - (a) CSD collecting old decorative lights. Randy - Brackets for mounting banners? CSD has.
- (3) Flooding/drainage has been a problem in the past. Highway changes has added three more blocks of drainage to that side of town.
- b) Infrastructure Needs
 - i) Manuel Quintana (General Manager of the Esparto CSD) explained the CSD Infrastructure Needs
 - (1) Well on west side of town.
 - (2) Talking to County regarding getting a grant to fund a recycled water plant of wastewater for irrigation. Pipes could bring this water to Tuli-Mem, downtown park, and maybe to the high school too. The new developments will add 286 EDU's (equivalent dwelling units) or 64,000 gpd additional to the wastewater facility. Average right now is 200,000 gal.
 - (3) Reviewing bids to slip line sewer along Fremont St. CCTV of old sewer main leaving Madison and Alpha going towards sewer plant, and improvements to sewers in an alley on north end., low spots trap grease.
 - (4) Downtown park needs a shade structure. Need to put on everyone's radar ECAC, CVV.
- c) Other
 - i) S. Reed – fence for OHV's has been open.
 - ii) S. Reed – talked to Dollar General about trash and landscaping. Was told they are trying to find a budget to.
 - iii) S. Reed – coupons twice a year to dispose of bulky items.
