Day #1 – Wednesday, June 12, 2024

Segment: Capay Dam to the Syar Industries LLC Madison Plant Site

Meeting Place: We will be meeting at the Syar Industries LLC Madison Plant Site, consolidate vehicles, and carpool to the starting point at the Capay Dam.

Directions from West Main Street in Woodland: Head west on State Route 16. After you go over Interstate 505, turn right on County Road 89 at the roundabout. Proceed north until you reach the gates to the plant site.

Day #2 – Thursday, June 13, 2024

Segment: Syar Industries LLC Madison Plant Site to Cache Creek Nature Preserve

Meeting Place: We will be meeting at the Cache Creek Nature Preserve, consolidate vehicles, and carpool to the Syar Industries LLC Madison Plant Site.

Directions from West Main Street in Woodland: Head west on State Route 16. Continue straight on County Road 22 (do not veer to the left on State Route 16 at the West Valley Baptist Church). Turn right on County Road 94B and travel north over the creek. Turn left on County Road 20. The gates to the Nature Preserve will be on the left about 0.3 miles down the road.

Day #3 – Friday, June 14, 2024

Segment: Cache Creek Nature Preserve to Huff's Corner at Interstate 5

Meeting Place: We will be meeting at the Cache Creek Nature Preserve and begin the day's walk from there. We will get carpooled from the end back to the Nature Preserve.
