

# FREE NALOXONE FROM YOLO COUNTY

## Reverses most opioid overdoses, including fentanyl

### Help Save a Life!

Naloxone is used as treatment for opioid emergency such as overdose or possible opioid overdose. Naloxone does not take the place of emergency medical care.

The steps below provide an overview of how to get, train, use, report an overdose reversal, and join the movement to reduce Opioid Overdose in Yolo County.







**STEP 1: GET** 

Dispense Naloxone via a Yolo County Wellness Vending Machine, find a machine near you at: <u>English, Spanish, Russian</u>



#### **STEP 2: TRAIN**

Complete required Training: <u>English</u> | <u>Spanish</u> | Russian (Coming Soon) Then log training was completed: <u>English</u> | Spanish (Coming Soon) | Russian (Coming Soon)



#### **STEP 3: USE**

Use the Naloxone to reverse an overdose



#### **STEP 4: REPORT**

Report the Overdose Reversal, complete the form: <u>English</u> | Spanish (Coming Soon) | Russian (Coming Soon)
