#### **Recommended Action**

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The applicant has requested that LAFCO waive all LAFCO fees and fee waiver fees, estimated at about \$1,800. The applicant will pay \$2000 in State Board of Equalization fees.

#### Reason for Recommended Action

This memo provides the Commission with formal notice of the receipt of a new application. Staff will provide appropriate notice and requests for information to affected agencies and interested individuals, consistent with Government Code section 56857(a).

The property owners requested a waiver of all LAFCO fees, since the annexation is part of an effort to help clean up and clarify the Yolo County RCD boundaries.


#### Background

In updating the Yolo County RCD map, staff identified several parcels that were not clearly inside or outside of the RCD boundaries. The Commission directed staff to contact the property owners of these parcels to determine if they would like to be included in the District. Mr. Peart responded that he was receiving services from the District and would like his property to be included in the RCD boundaries. Annexation would allow the District's legal boundaries to conform to RCD services. Additionally, this annexation would create a more logical service boundary, since most of the properties in Yolo County that surround the proposal area are in the District. None of the other property owners that were contacted have responded.

The Peart application was received on January 16, 2008. The applicant proposes to annex four parcels with a total of approximately 400 acres to the RCD. LAFCO staff will prepare the annexation map with use of the new Geographic Information System (GIS) tools and support from Yolo County and Los Angeles LAFCO GIS personnel. Yolo LAFCO staff will process the application and coordinate with all affected agencies and interested parties.


