7.	Yard Trimming Collection Schedule Change The Committee will briefly discuss the results of this Summer's vote by the property owners within the Willowbank County Service Area. The property owners favored changing the schedule of yard trimming pile collections (claw pickups) from the current 12 collections per year (once per month) to 15 collections per year by adding 3 collections of per year during leaf fall season (November, December & January). The County-run ballot process of property owners had a 71% response rate, with 53% favoring the increase (44 to 39). Supervisor Jim Provenza has concluded that the vote was a reliable illustration of WCSA desire. The County will be communicating the results shortly. The communication will include the details of how the change in our collection schedule will be implemented. The County Supervisors are expected to have a consent-calendar vote on the change later this month.	Lawyer
8.	Yard Trimming Piles Placement Enforcement	Lawyer

Discussions will cover how the Committee and community can increase compliance with existing rules on when and where yard trimming piles can be placed in our streets for collection by the claw. Discussion will include bike path rules and enforcement process challenges. Ideas generated from these discussions will be utilized to initiate implementation towards future compliance.

9. Montgomery Driving Safety

Excessive driving speeds on Montgomery and potential remedies will be discussed.

10. Greater Willowbank Improvement Association (GWIA)

A further discussion of GWIA, the organization's mission, and it's current status will be provided. Options of how to integrate the missions of GWIA with the WCSA/CAC will be discussed as will the viability of these options.

11. Street Sweeping

A brief update will be provided on the assessments of the feasibility of street sweeping in Willowbank.

12. Improvement of Contact List for Willowbank WCSA/CAC

Discussions of the revised list of property owner contacts will be provided. A process will be discussed for requesting emails from the remaining property owners for which we do not have an electronic means of communicating County business. Of the 129 Willowbank CSA property owners, we do not have email addresses for 36%.
