Any person who is dissatisfied with the recommendations of this Technical Advisory Committee may submit their comments to the Planning and Public Works Director prior to the decision. Decisions of the Planning and Public Works Director may be appealed to the Planning Commission by filing with the Clerk of the Planning Commission within fifteen days from the date of the decision. A written notice of appeal specifying the grounds and an appeal fee immediately payable to the Clerk of the Planning Commission must be submitted at the time of filing. The Planning Commission may sustain, modify, or overrule the Planning and Public Works Director's decision.
