#### I-505 Habitat Enhancement/Erosion Control Proposed Demonstration Project

A site visit was made to gather input regarding to possible projects located along the north bank of Cache Creek, west of the I-505 Bridge. Both projects would include bank stabilization and habitat enhancement utilizing bio-techniques.

The first site is adjacent to the Scheuring property. It would be used as a demonstration project to enhance a site that has been previously planted (unsuccessfully). The purpose of the project would be to provide bank stabilization while creating native habitat. The primary attraction to the site is the landowner's willingness to provide water and the continuing goal of providing protection for the I-505 bridge.

The second site is adjacent to the Tuttle Property. The need for bank stabilization, through biotechniques is apparent in that the Creek has continued to impact the bank at an accelerated rate. It was suggested that planting, in part, utilize vegetation taken from a point sandbar that appears to be a significant contributor to the meandering of the Creek at this location. It was the conclusion of the TAC that immediate "emergency" action is not necessary but that bank erosion mitigation is needed.

Both projects will be discussed in more detail, eventually in the form of a concept plan, at future TAC meetings.
