Tire Amnesty Events in Yolo County

(Woodland, CA) – Two tire amnesty events will be held in Yolo County in March for the collection of used passenger car, truck and farm tractor tires. During these one-day events, sponsored by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) "Zero Waste – You Make it Happen" program, there will be no charge for the disposal of used tires.

What: Tire Amnesty Event (free disposal of used tires)

Where: Sat., Mar. 7, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon

Yolo County Central Landfill, 44090 County Road 28H, Woodland

Note: limit of 20 tires per vehicle

Sat., Mar. 28, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Esparto Convenience Center, County Road 19A & 87, Esparto

Note: limit of 20 tires per vehicle

- For both events, if you are hauling more than nine waste tires, you must obtain a waste tire hauler permit, or request an exemption from the Yolo County Environmental Health Department, Local Enforcement Agency. Call (530) 666-8646 for more information on exemptions. Members of the Farm Bureau may call (530) 662-6316 for assistance with hauler permits.
- Tires that will be accepted include all passenger vehicle, truck, and tractor tires that are air filled with no solid areas.
- Tires with rims will be accepted, but heavy equipment tires will not be accepted.
- Tire bins full of tires will not be accepted at these events. If you have tire bins full of tires you may contact Tri C Tire Recycling directly at (530) 661-6906 for proper management of your tires.
