GLASS

- All beverage & food containers, labels okay
- All colors, lids removed
- Rinsed & empty

Please No window glass, mirrors, drinking glasses, ceramics, light bulbs, or fluorescent tubes.



MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper
- Magazines, catalogs & glossy paper
- Brown Paper bags
- Paper packaging
- Junk mail
- Phone books
- All color paper
- Envelopes, with & without windows
- Tag board (cereal boxes & shoe boxes)
- Cardboard—flattened



No hardcover books, paper tissues or paper towels, No paper with plastic coatings, paper with food on it, waxed or foil lined paper or tyvek (non-tearing) envelopes.

Hardcover books can be donated to Goodwill or Reuse centers.



CALIFORNIA REFUND VALUE (CRV) is the cash refund you will earn when you recycle your empty CRV bottles and cans.

Take CRV containers to a recycling center within Yolo County and receive the cash refund.
