7. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- a) Fire Severity Zones: The Department of Housing and Community Development is in the process of readopting emergency regulations for ignition-resistant construction systems within the Wildland Urban Interface to include emergency regulations for ignition-resistant construction systems for manufactured homes, mobilehomes, multifamily manufactured homes, and commercial modulars. Any stick-built home, manufactured home, mobile home, or other structure installed or intended to be installed on a parcel located within a state responsibility or local responsibility area within a fire severity zone is required to be constructed with an ignition resistant construction system. Manufactured homes manufactured on or after January 1, 2006, and prior to September 1, 2008, are exempt from this requirement. However, manufactured homes manufactured before January 1, 2006, are required to comply with the ignition resistant construction system requirement. All ancillary structures are also required to comply with the ignition resistant construction system requirement, unless a written request for a waiver is submitted to the Chief Building Official for review and approval.
