**SACRAMENTO MAN SENTENCED TO MAXIMUM OF 19 YEARS IN PRISON
FOR CARJACKING**

(Woodland, CA) – April 27, 2009 District Attorney Jeff Reisig announced that on April 23, 2009 Miguel Angel Castillo, of Sacramento, was sentenced to the maximum sentence under California law for carjacking with the use of a firearm. Superior Court Judge Arvid Johnson handed down the sentence to Castillo, who was convicted by jury in March 2009.

Castillo went to the Merritt Landing boat ramp in West Sacramento on July 30th, 2007, and stuck a sawed off shotgun in the face of a man who was sitting in his truck. Castillo told him to get out of his truck if he didn't want to die. Days later Castillo fled from the truck after being seen by Sacramento Police officers, who later took him into custody.

Yolo County District Attorney Jeff Reisig credited the Sacramento Police Department officers with an excellent follow up investigation.
