2009-2010 Budget Resolution

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Board amend its action for item 4.03 to review and, after making any modifications to the proposed budget, approve the attached Budget Acceptance Resolution and adopt the FY 2009-2010 budget for Yolo County Housing (YCH).

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The attached HUD-52574 PHA Board Resolution Approving the Operating Budget was omitted from the agenda package. The Board Resolution is required of all Public Housing Agencies and, according to HUD Regulations, is due before the beginning of the fiscal year. As part of the budget approval process, the Board should also approve this resolution so that it may be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

As a financially troubled agency, YCH is also required to submit the Board approved Budget to HUD. Staff estimates that once the Board approves the draft budget, it can be formatted to meet HUD submission requirements and will be submitted no later than June 25, which is so indicated on the HUD-52574.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None at this time. Failure to submit the HUD-52574 could have financial implications that are unknown at this time.

CONCLUSION:
